Once there was a small meadow (a field covered with grass) near a lake. Thousands of mice lived there.

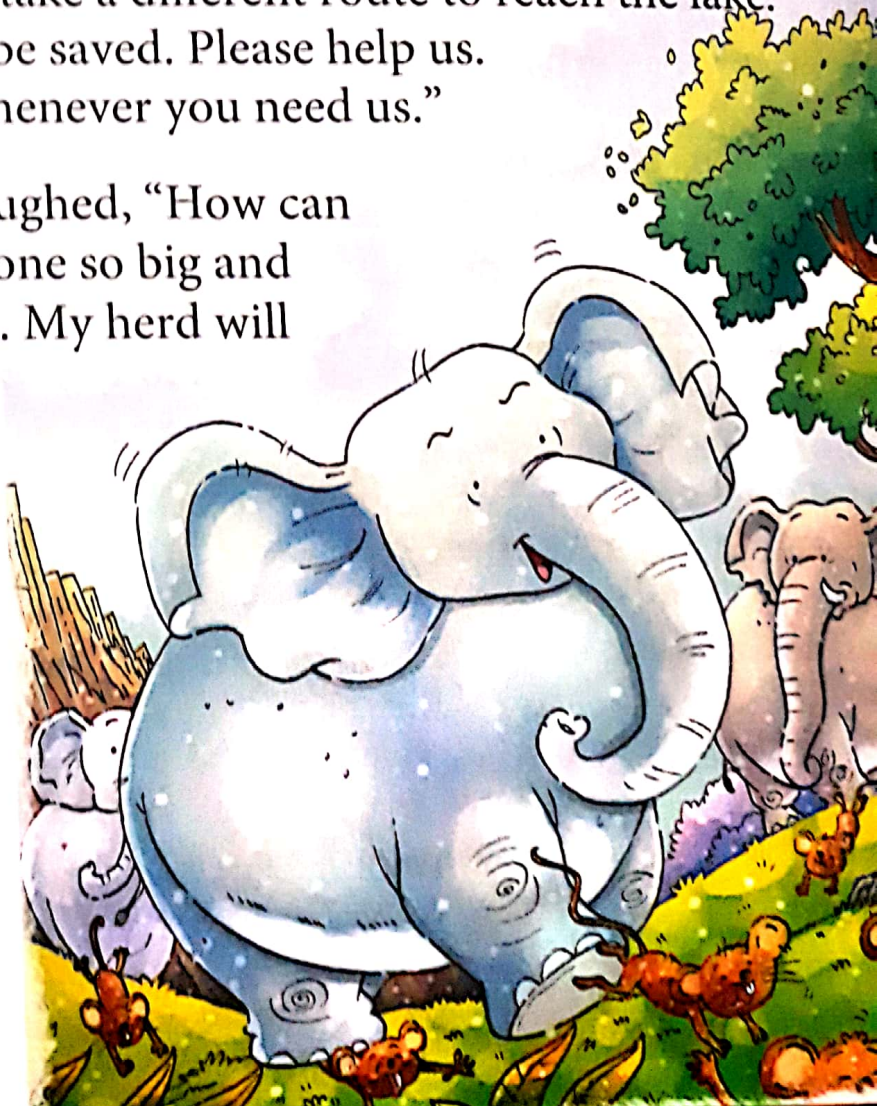

The king of mice became worried, "Oh my God! One day all the mice would get killed. I should meet the king of elephants."

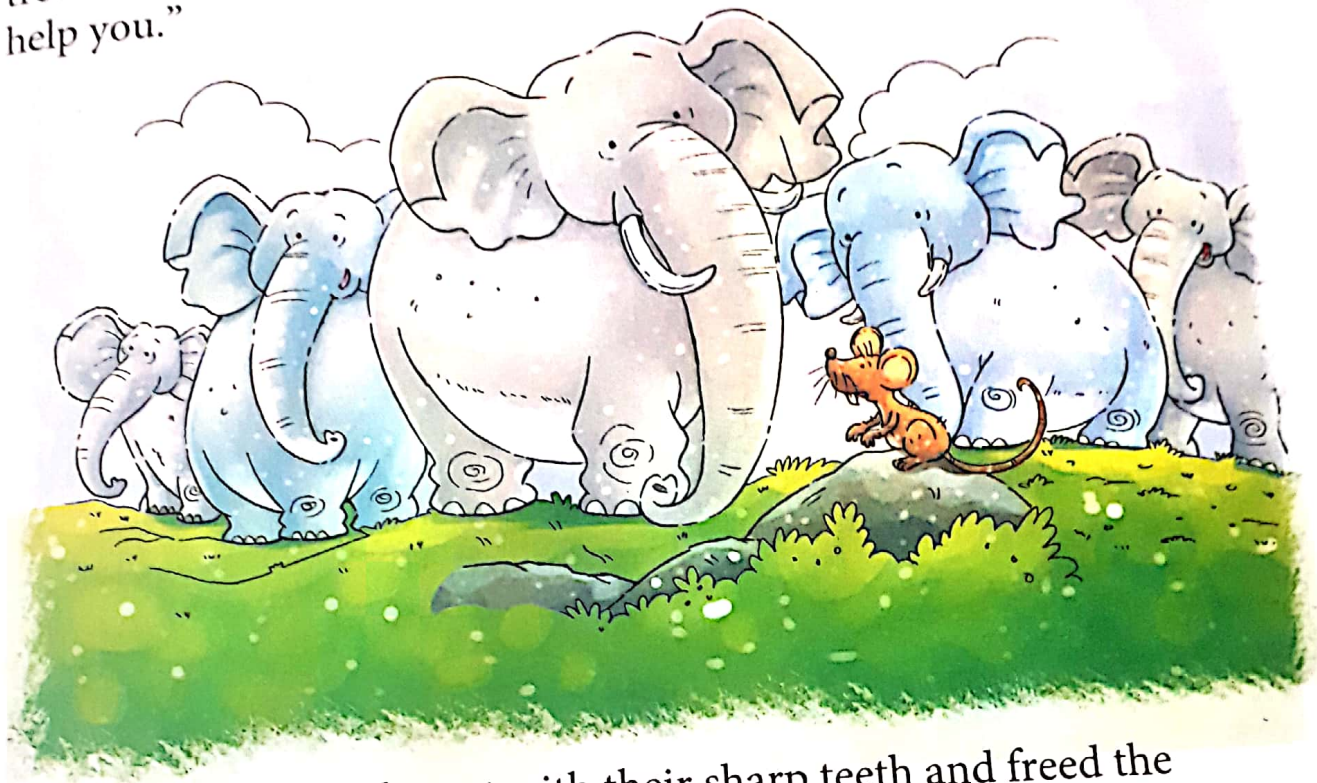

Some months later, hunters caught a large elephant in a net. The elephants were helpless now.

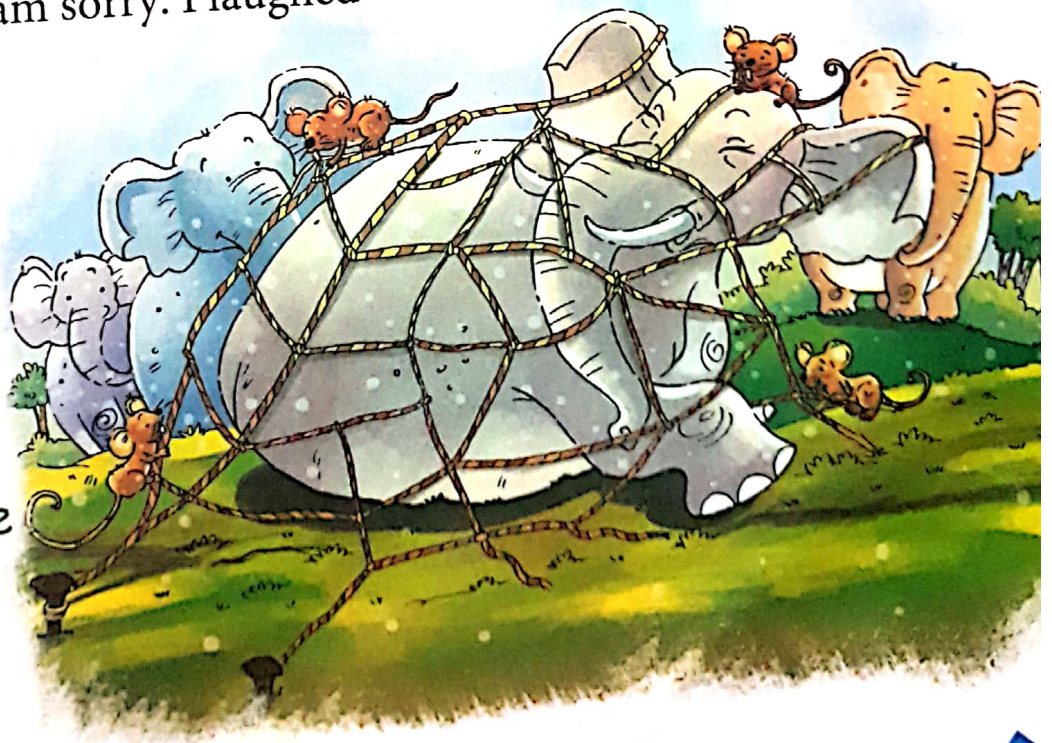
